WHY NATIVE PLANTS MATTER

Over the past century, the continental U.S. lost a staggering 150 million acres of habitat and farmland to urban sprawl, and that trend isn't slowing. The remaining isolated natural areas are not large enough to support wildlife and that is where you come in. By using native plants in your landscape you provide habitat and food for our insects, birds and wildlife.

Native plants are adapted to the local climate and soil conditions where they naturally occur. These important plant species provide nectar, pollen, and seeds that serve as food for native butterflies, insects, birds and other animals. Unlike natives, common horticultural plants do not provide energetic rewards for their visitors and can require more care to survive. Non-native plant species do not have these connections to native birds and can create 'food deserts' for our birds.

Consider these numbers:

- 96% of land birds feed insects to their chicks
- Native oak trees host over 530 species of caterpillars; non-native ginkgo trees host just 4
- To raise one nest of chickadee babies, parents must find between 6,000 and 9,000 caterpillars
- Suburban yards planted with native species host 8 times more native birds, according to the work of entomologist Doug Tallamy.

Colorful Entry

Make a statement in your entryway! Be sure to choose plants with a variety of colors! Features: large pot, decorative round stones.

Add excitement to the parkway strip along your driveway by adding plants that butterflies and other pollinators love. Features: stepping stones and contrasting colors.



Living Wall

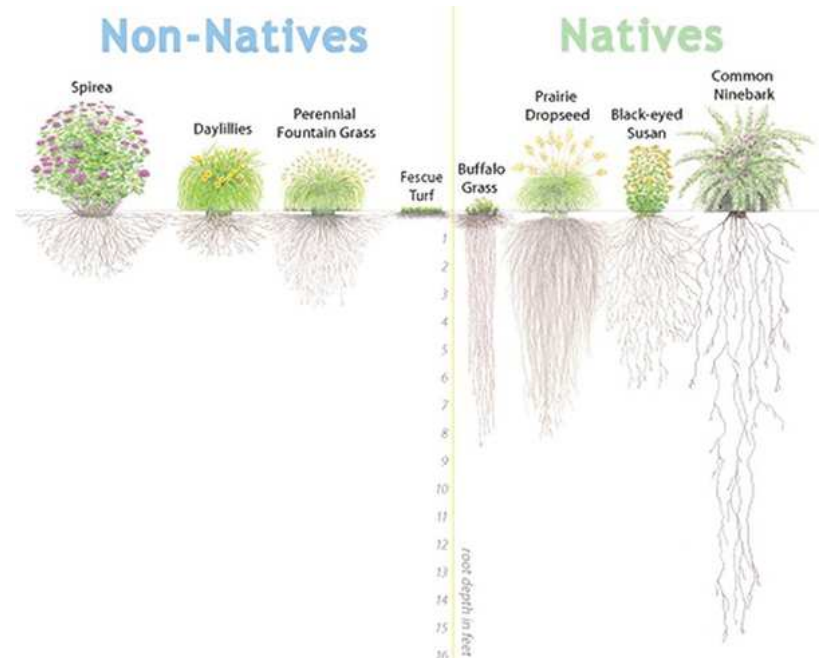

Native plants are also advantageous, because:

- **Native plants require less water than lawns and help prevent erosion.** The deep root systems of many native Midwestern plants increase the soil's capacity to store water. Native plants can significantly reduce water runoff and, consequently, flooding.
- **Native plants provide shelter and food for wildlife.**
- **Native plants promote biodiversity and stewardship of our natural heritage.**
- **Native plants are beautiful and increase aesthetics!**
